

## FOR FIRST-TIME JUDGES

Follow these instructions asap if you are a first-time judge with Capitol BEST.

### Accessing the Online Scoring Manager 2024


If you are volunteering for a Game Day duty that involves judging, you will need to access our Online Scoring Manager site. You can access the site in two ways:

- Directly at the url <https://osm.bestrobotics.org>
- Via the National Registry “Judging” page, which will become available after you are approved as a judge.

The Online Scoring Manager is where all rubrics/scoresheets are found and where you will enter your scores for each team. The first time that you login to the Online Scoring Manager, you will associate it with your new National Registry account, linking the two systems through the same login credentials. **WE NEED YOU TO LOGIN IMMEDIATELY to complete this association so that we can finalize judging assignments within the Online Scoring Manager.**

The process is

- 1) Navigate to <https://osm.bestrobotics.org>
- 2) Click the Login button
- 3) Then click the Registry button
- 4) Enter your National Registry account credentials (if already logged into the Registry this will fly through)
- 5) Upon automatic return to Online Scoring Manager, click the REGISTER button (this associates the account between the two systems). There will be no confirmation email sent, ignore that note.

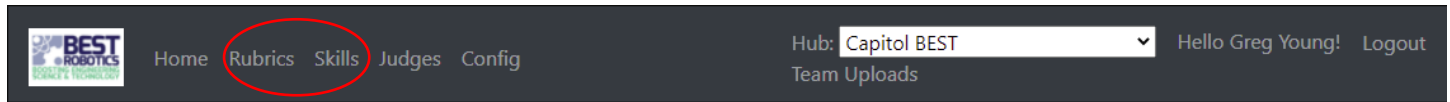

## Using the Online Scoring Manager

After your assignments are complete, you will see menu options become available in the Online Scoring Manager site. The two menu items will be “Rubrics” and/or “Skills”.



The Rubrics page includes judging of BEST Award category components:

- Engineering Notebooks,
- Marketing Presentations and
- Team Exhibits & Interviews
- Spirit & Sportsmanship (not judged in 2021)


The Skills page includes judging of our Skills Challenges such as:

- Critical Design Review
- Engineering Drawings Challenge
- Robot Modeling Challenge
- Video Design Challenge
- Website Design Challenge

The Rubrics or Skills pages will give you access to the scoresheets for each participating team that you have been assigned to judge. Click on the “assigned” or “optional” link under the appropriate column for the team you are judging to open the scoresheet. After saving the scoresheet, your score will be reflected similar to that shown below.
